All peer services moved to the state plan per CMS direction. Housing assistance services have changed to tenancy type supports per CMS direction.  
**Needs based criteria and eligibility determination are key factors with this approach.**  
There are several details about this waiver that are still being reviewed with CMS so the actual services that are going to be in it are still being finalized.
