Governmental Affairs/Legislative Update:

Emily Henderson, Governmental Affairs Consultant and Lobbyist for Arc Michigan with McCall Hamilton.

Emily shared this link for the <u>Tracking Status Report</u> on Education bills. It is a live link and can be bookmarked to check current status on bills of interest to the Arc MI Education Committee. Education Committee members will receive bi-weekly updates on Education bills via email.

Federal budget discussions, MI House (rep) Senate (dem). Budget negotiations are kicking off next week. So far, the senate has been the only ones to propose toward the Oct. 1 date. The <u>Consensus Revenue Estimating Conference</u> was held May 16th and it looks like there may be more money available in the school aid budget. Negotiations will continue over the summer. MI House republicans not moving any bills by Senate democrats. Senate democrats are not taking up any republican sponsored bills, so things are moving slowly. The budget for school aid is due July 1st. Discussed talks on the banning of transgender students participating in male/female sports in schools. Discussion on the School Safety bill package (HB 4222-4229) having passed on one floor, waiting on the other.

Michelle sent requests to MDE OSE for the development of new Family Matters Fact Sheets. Responses from MDE OSE are in parentheses

- Compensatory Education (this issue is part of OCR-MDE lawsuit, so development and
 release of the fact sheet is uncertain. OSE agreed that it is needed; it is waiting for
 approval to move forward. There are 2 pieces of compensatory education- reactive
 (involving the state) that addresses compensatory education ordered through a state
 complaint or due process hearing and proactive (the school district or ISD determines
 the need for compensatory services because a student was not provided with FAPE). If
 approved, OSE will start with the reactive piece.
- Response to Intervention (RTI) (OSE will work on this)
- Individualized Healthcare Plans (IHPs) and IEPs (Drafts of 2 documents are being reviewed)
- Dyslexia legislation (being developed) (was requested by an ISD administrator)
