Review Agenda

Approval of Meeting Minutes: Meeting minutes from October reviewed and approved.

Governmental Affairs/Legislative Update:

Emily Henderson, Governmental Affairs Consultant and Lobbyist for Arc Michigan with McCall Hamilton.

One more full week of session then gone from November 18 to December 2. After that, there are only 9 session days left this year. Expecting rest of year to be quiet. Supplemental funding discussions will begin next year. Some funding items cut in school budget. Consolidates funding streams for 32p (Great Start Collaboratives, Family Coalitions, and home visiting) Book Supp to contain some of the funds for education that were cut. Expecting some things that were cut to be put back into supplemental funding. Emily will keep Michelle up to do date on that.

HB 5044 would require the board of a school district, ISD, or PSA to develop and adopt a policy to allow students to receive medically necessary treatment in the school setting if that child had a prescription and order from a private health care specialist. Michelle, on behalf of The Arc MI Education Committee, submitted the list of concerns and questions from committee members to Sherri Boyd.

Several education organizations, including the Michigan Association of Administrators of Special Education, Michigan Elementary and Middle School Principals Association, and the Michigan Education Association have come out in opposition. The bills are still in the Education Committee and have not yet received a vote.

The Arc is addressing concerns with the stakeholders, leading the effort as we share similar concerns that the aforementioned education groups have with the bill.

Noted articles in Bridge about low rates of kids attending school. Getting kids actively engaged in school. Discussion on fiscal repercussions on implementing the bill in schools.

SB 492-reported out of committee. Requires schools to confirm a student's enrollment at a new school before releasing their records, when a student has been transferred. This is to ensure a student transferring from one school to another is not disenrolled until the records are accepted at the new school. Currently waiting for vote on senate floor.
